Sex Offender to be Released in Sparta

The Sparta Police Department, in conjunction with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections, is notifying the public of the intended release of Clay G. Slater, to the community. Mr. Slater is a registered sex offender and will be staying on Water ST in the downtown area, in the City of Sparta. His intended release date is October 26, 2010.

Mr. Slater was convicted in Monroe County of Second Degree Sexual Assault of a Child in 2002. In the past, his victims have been juvenile female acquaintances. Mr. Slater's activities will be monitored by various forms of electronic devices. He is not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs and is not allowed in bars, taverns or liquor stores. No unsupervised contact with minors.

The release of this information is intended to keep the public informed of sexual offenders who are residing in the community and cannot be used to threaten, harass or otherwise intimidate Mr. Slater.
