Sex Offender to be Released in Sparta

The Sparta Police Department, in conjunction with the Wisconsin Department of Corrections, is notifying the public of the intended release of James R. Dopp, to the community. Mr. Dopp is a registered sex offender and will be staying on Depot ST, in the 900 block, in the City of Sparta. His intended release date is August 31, 2010.

Mr. Dopp was convicted in Monroe County of Third Degree Sexual Assault in 2009, with a prior conviction in Monroe County of Fourth Degree Sexual Assault in 2004. In the past, his victims have been adult and juvenile female acquaintances. Mr. Dopp's activities will be monitored by various forms of electronic devices. He is not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs and is not allowed in bars, taverns or liquor stores. No unsupervised contact with minors.

The release of this information is intended to keep the public informed of sexual offenders who are residing in the community and cannot be used to threaten, harass or otherwise intimidate Mr. Dopp.
