## Chief's Report

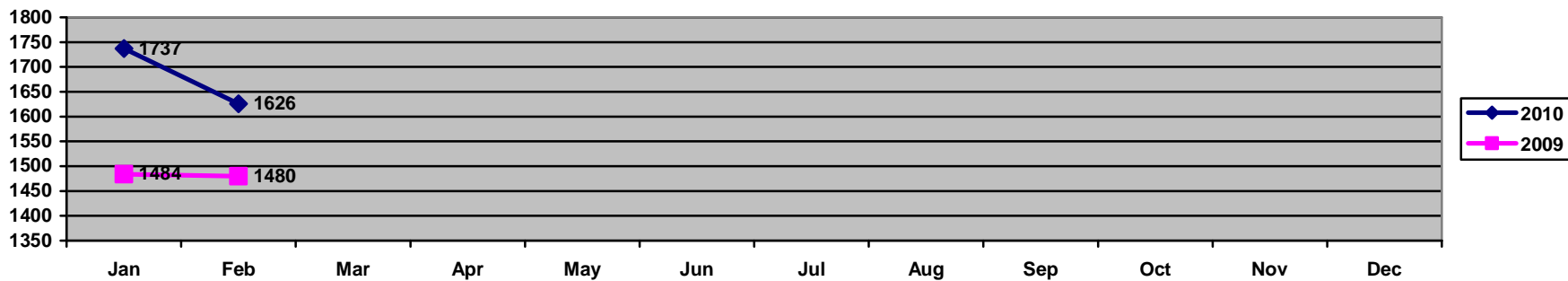

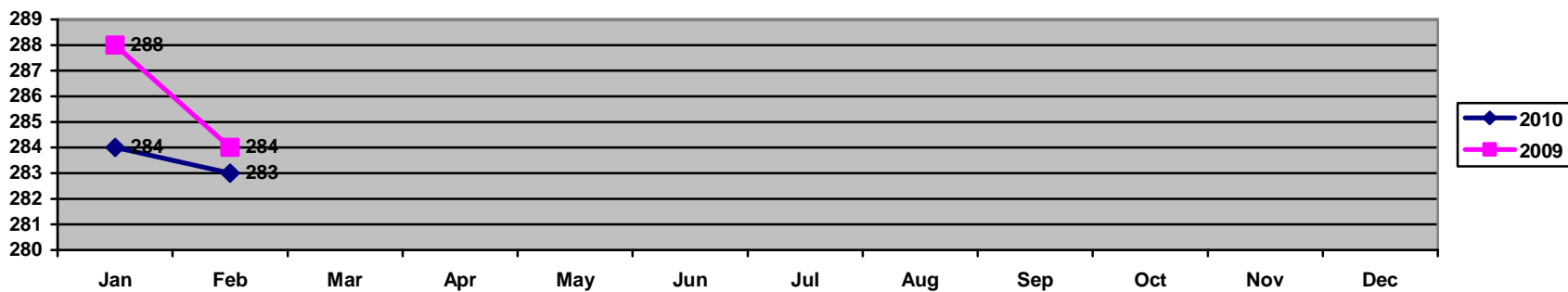
## Training

- Chief Kass, Lt. David Kuderer, and Lt. David Livingston completed Investigating Use of Force for Field Supervisors training program.

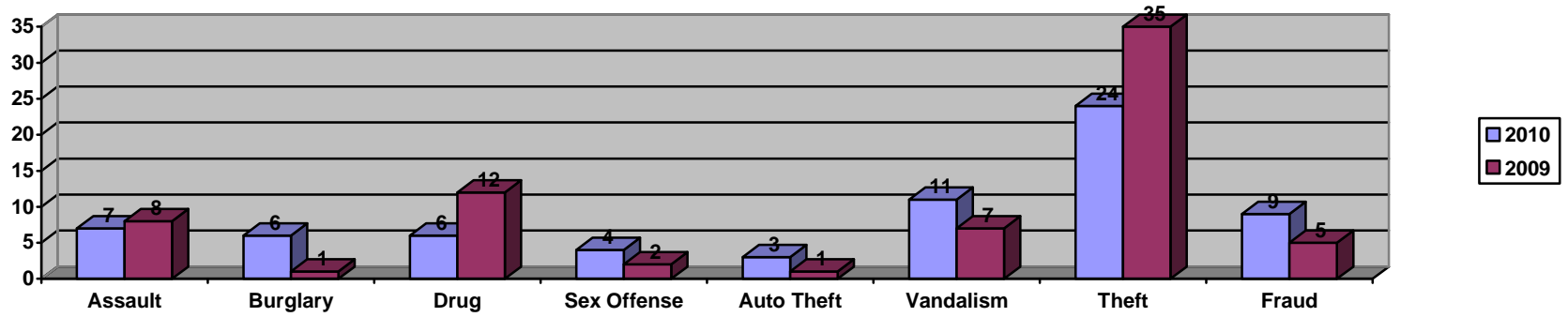
### 2009/2010 Year to Date Calls for Service



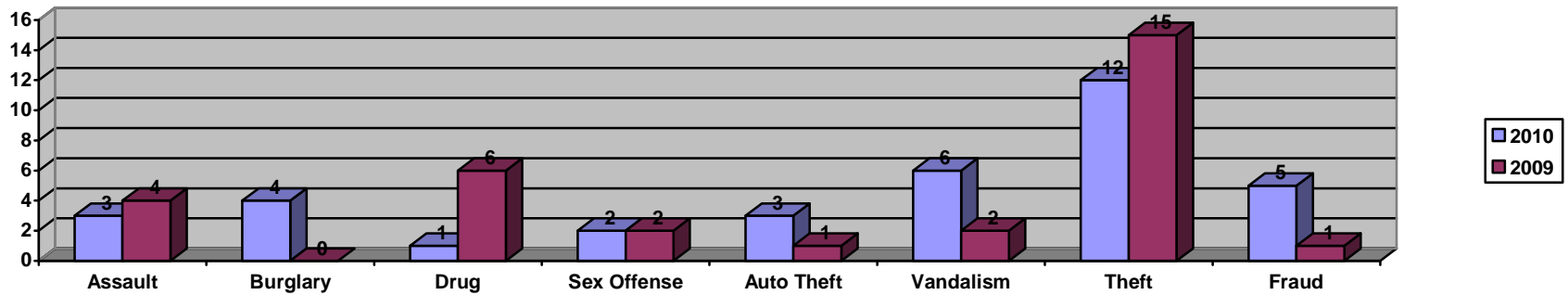
### 2008/2009 Year to Date Citations & Arrests



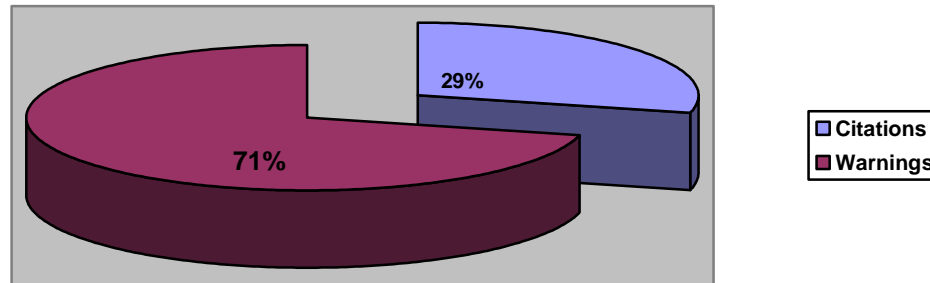
### Year to Date Major Crime Comparison Running Total 2009/2010
