During the month of June the Sparta Police Department responded to 1890 calls for service, issued 152 traffic citations, arrested 14 persons for Operating While Under the Influence and made 189 non-traffic related arrests. Overall activity level was comparable with the prior month.

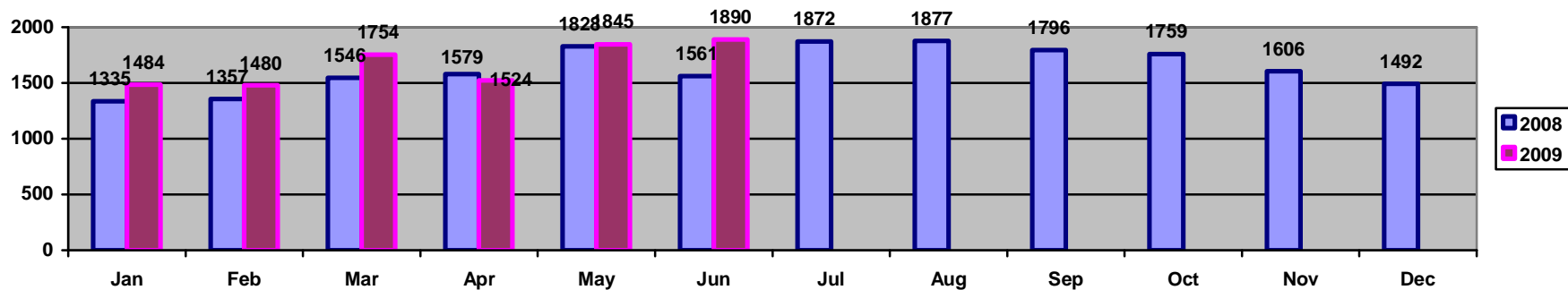

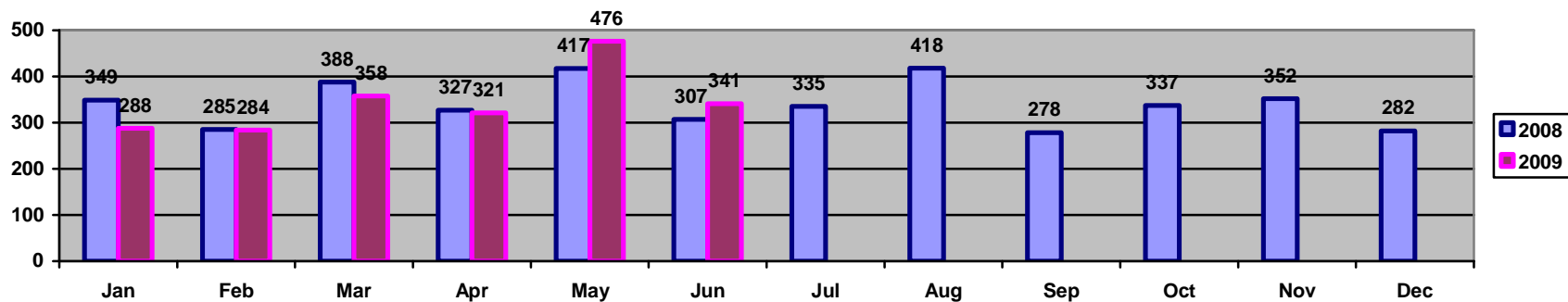
Training

- Officer Kyle Guralski attended Firearms Instructor training.

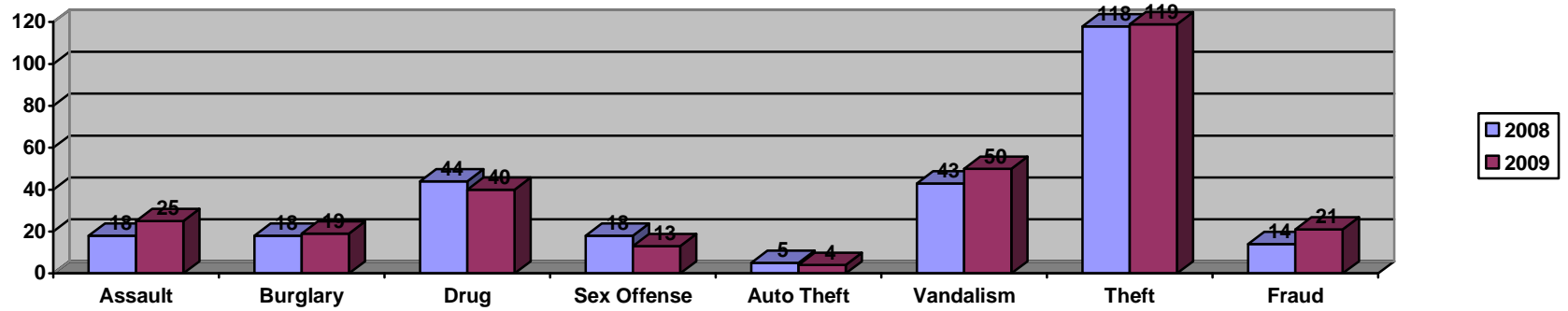
2008/2009 Year to Date Calls for Service



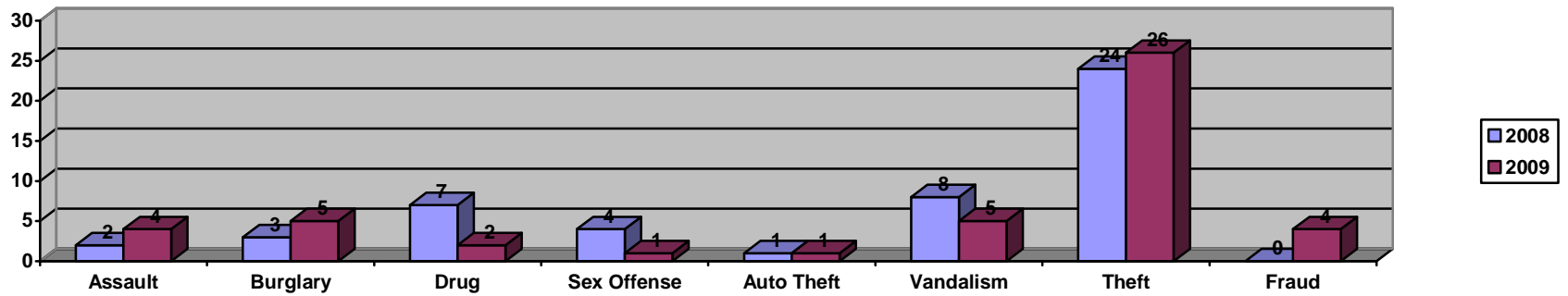
2008/2009 Year to Date Citations & Arrests



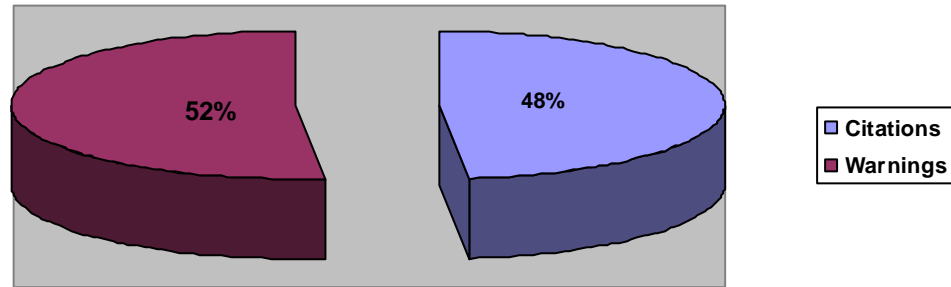
Year to Date Major Crime Comparison Running Total 2008/2009
