Activity Report:

During the month of June the Sparta Police Department responded to 1605 calls for service, issued 87 traffic citations, arrested 8 persons for Operating While Under the Influence and made 164 non-traffic related arrests. Overall activity level was significantly lower when compared with the prior year.

The Sparta Police Department participated in the annual Butterfest parade and celebration. Officers led the parade, provided traffic control, and regularly patrolled the fest grounds on foot and bicycle. The Department continues to investigate a potential kidnapping. A 16 year old girl was taken to Indiana by a 20 year old acquaintance against her will and without the family's permission. The 20 year old man was arrested in Indiana and is awaiting extradition back to Wisconsin.

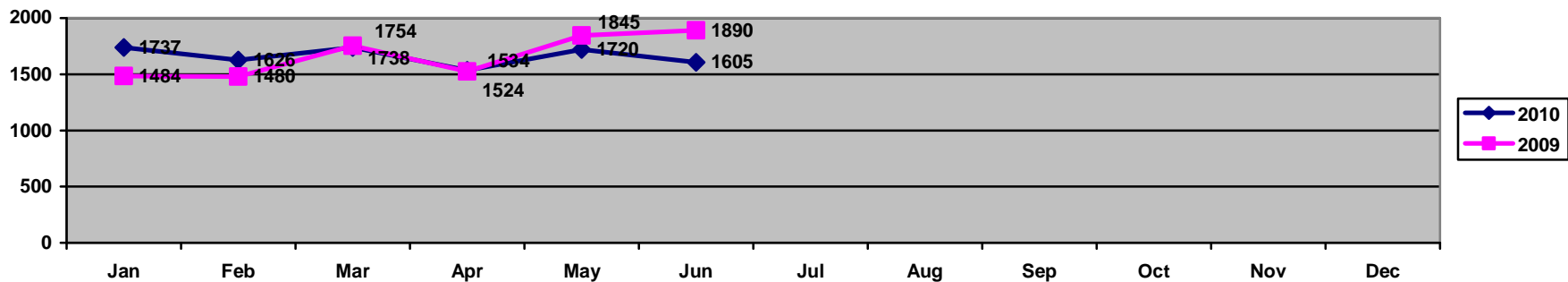

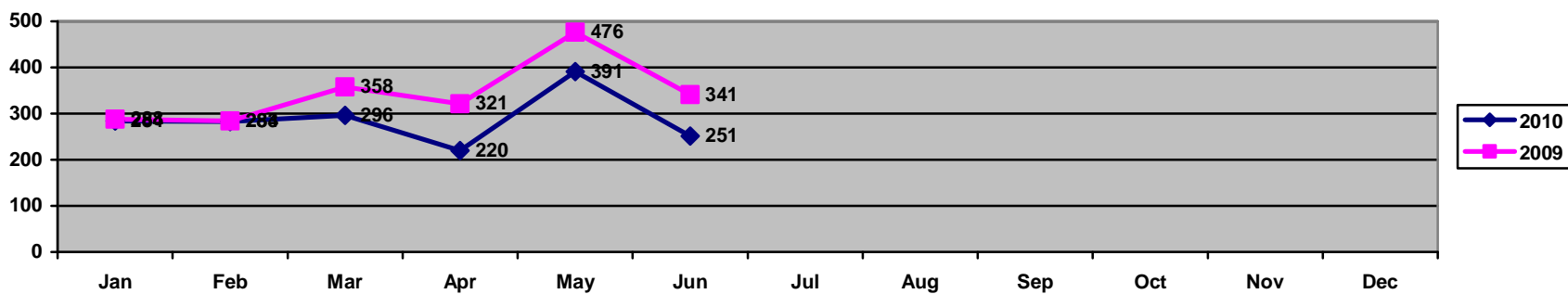
Training

- Administrative Assistant Heather Miller attended the Law Enforcement Administrative Assistant Training Conference.

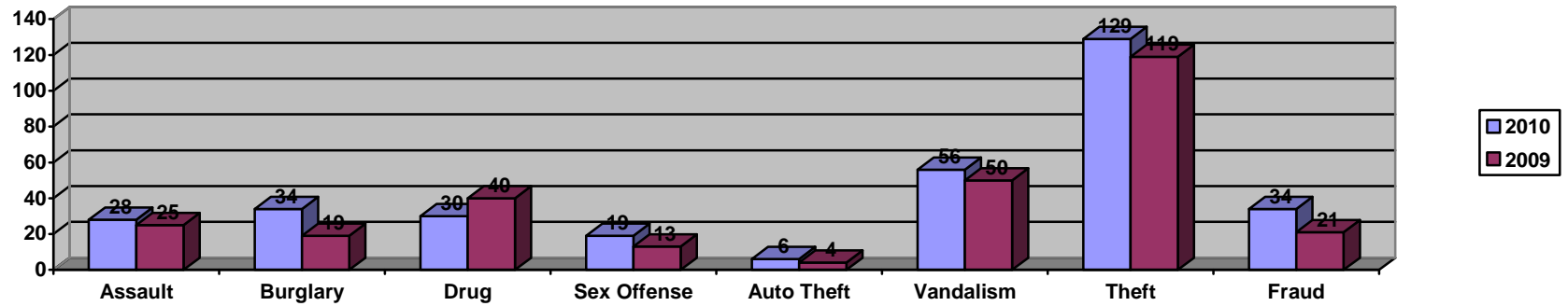
2009/2010 Year to Date Calls for Service



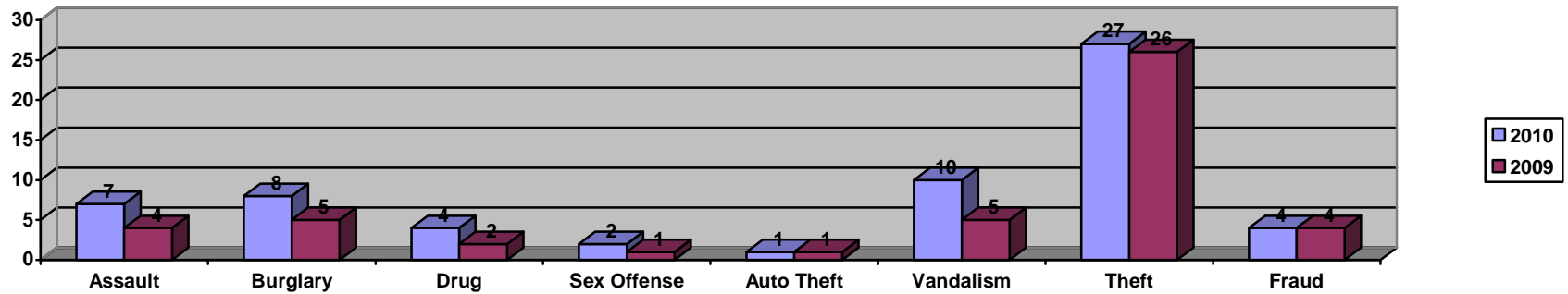
2009/2010 Year to Date Citations & Arrests



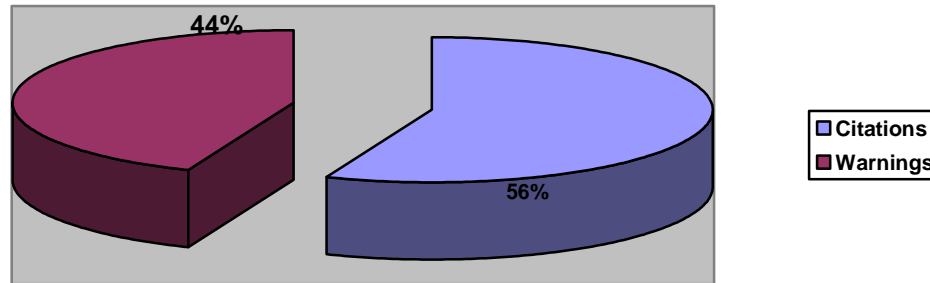
Year to Date Major Crime Comparison Running Total 2009/2010
